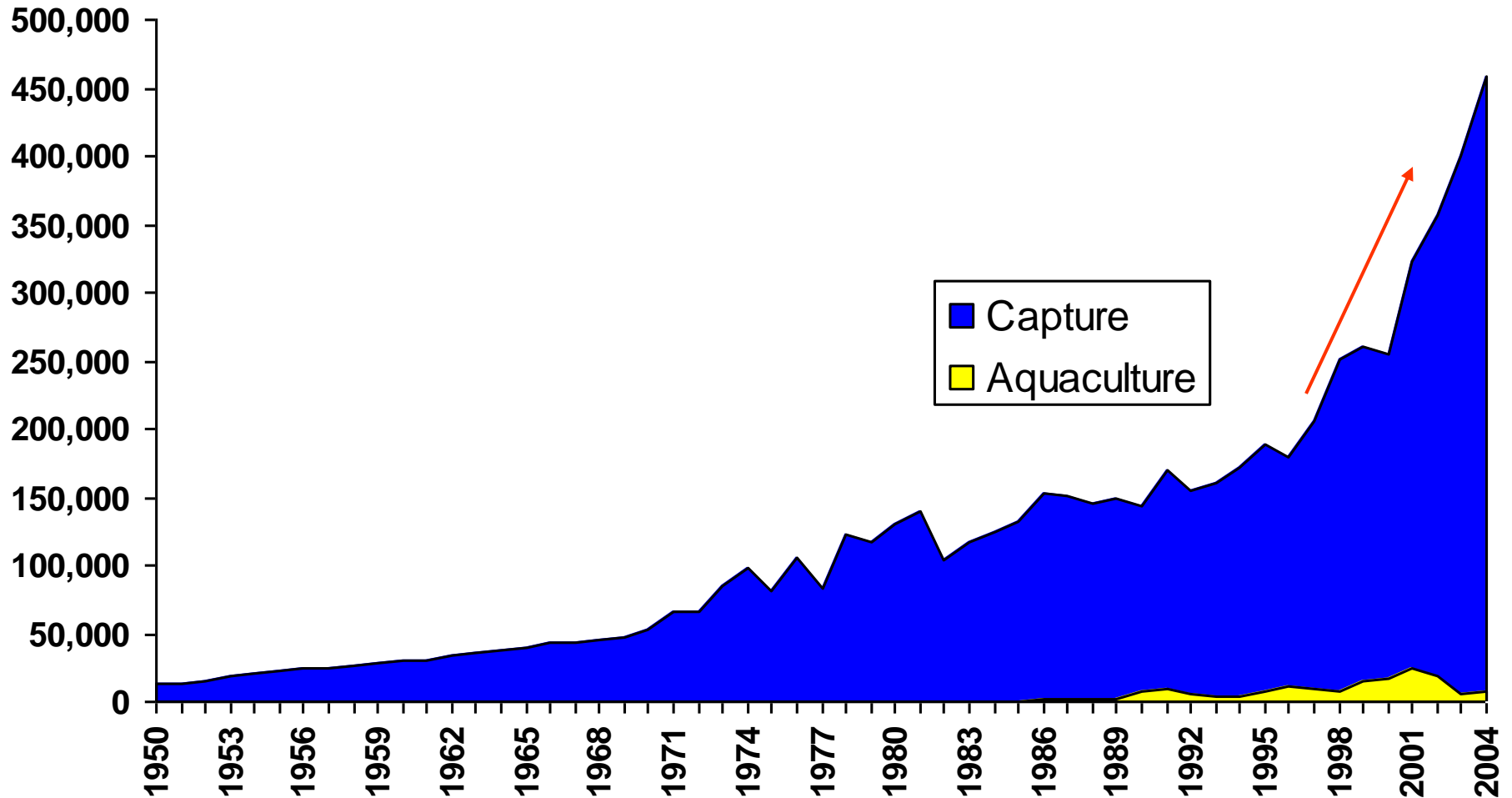

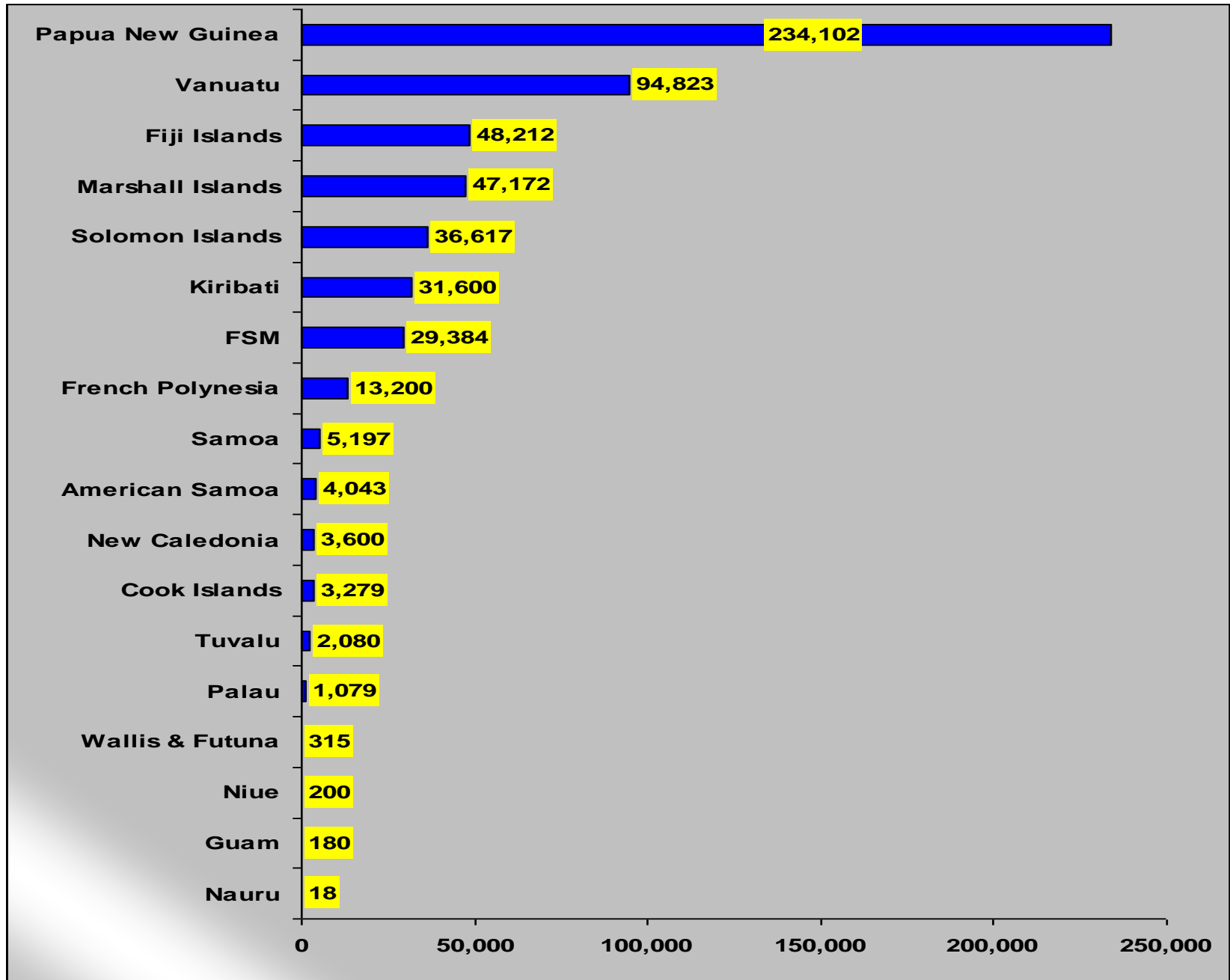
Some Facts

- Oceania contributes 0.012% towards the world's total catch.
- Australia and New Zealand form 63% of the catch from Oceania and the remaining 36% are from the Pacific Island Countries.
- Therefore, Pacific Island States comprise 0.005% of the world's total catch.

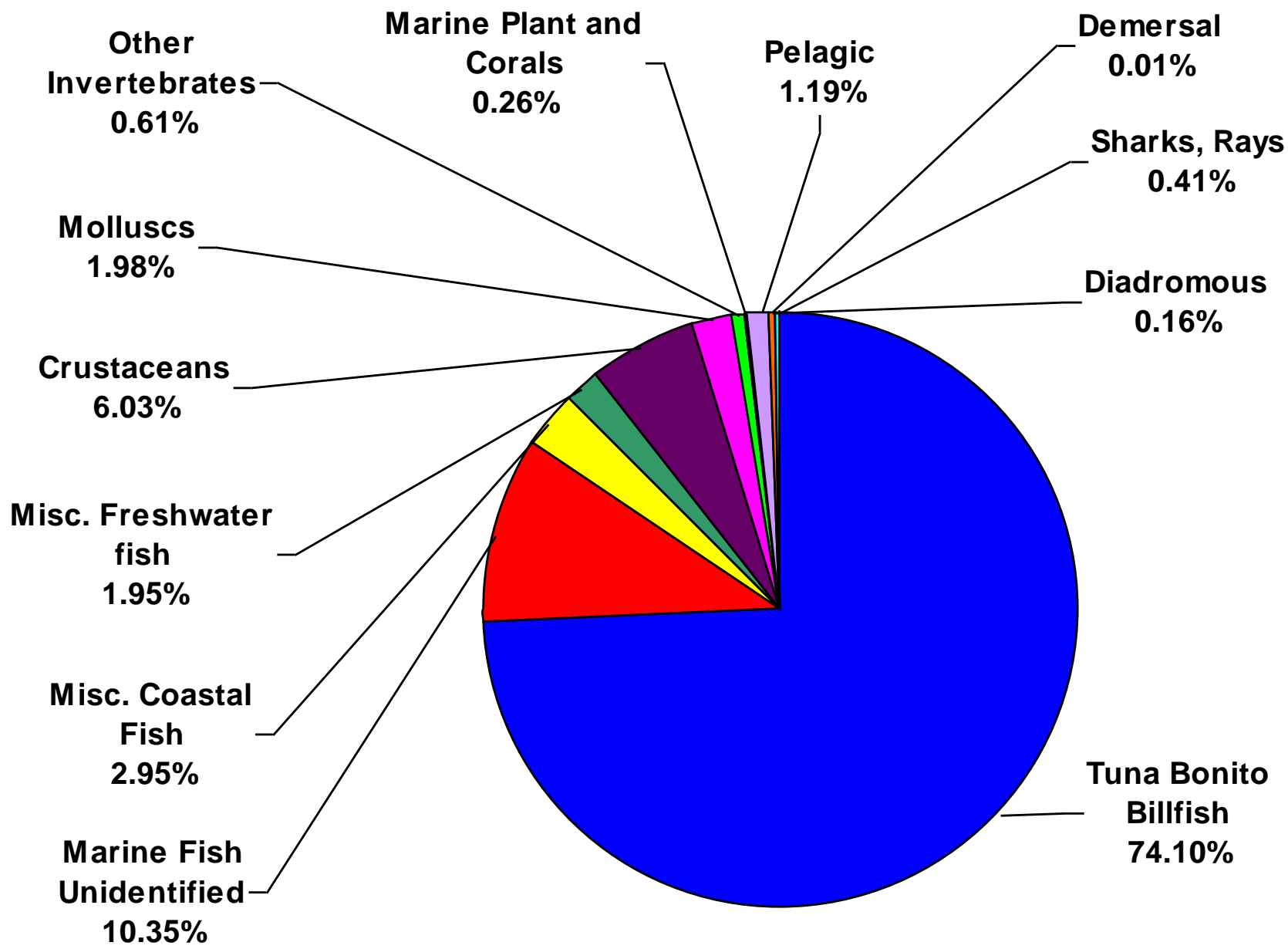
Pacific Islands production (tonnes) from capture fisheries and aquaculture



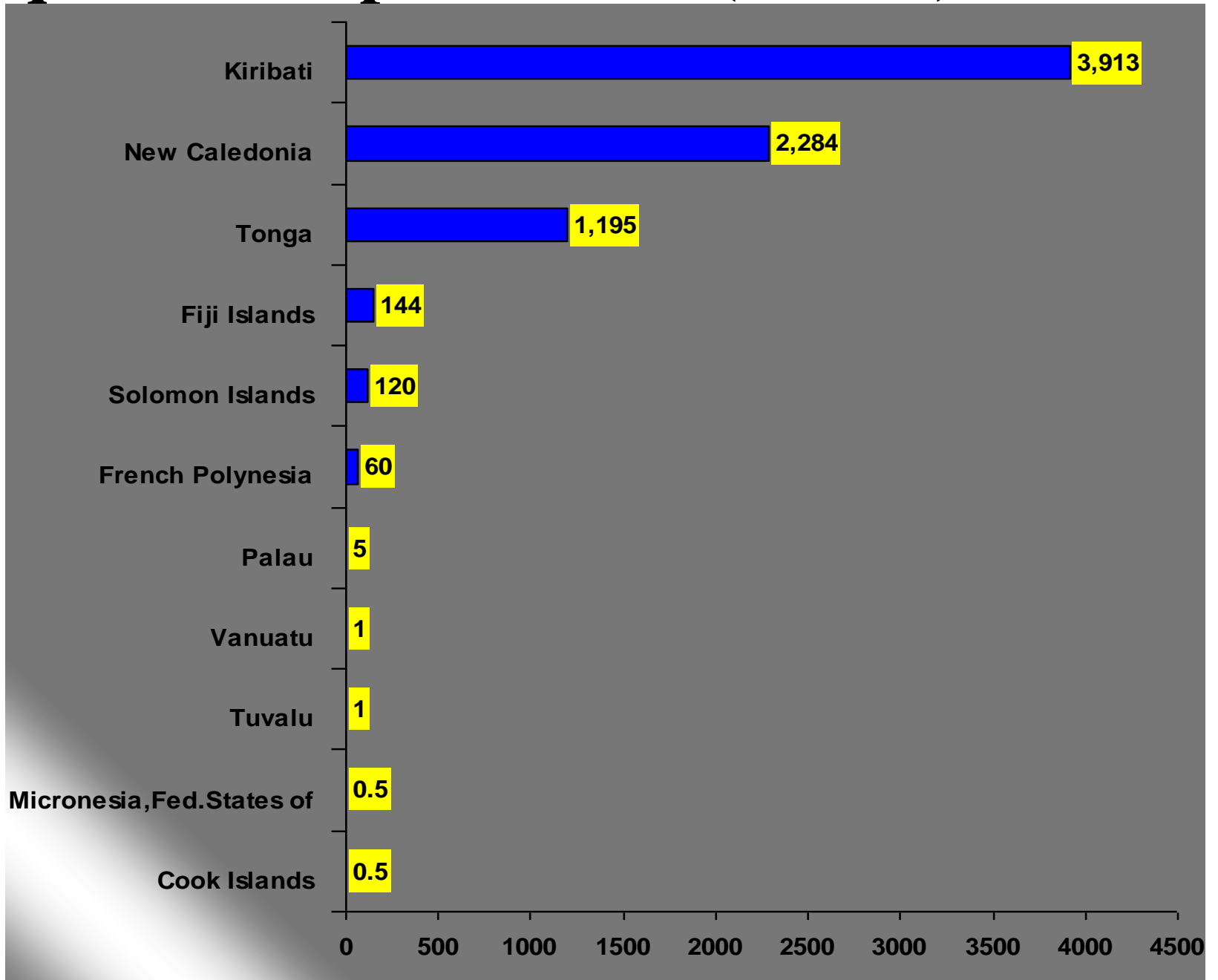
Capture fisheries production (tonnes) in 2004



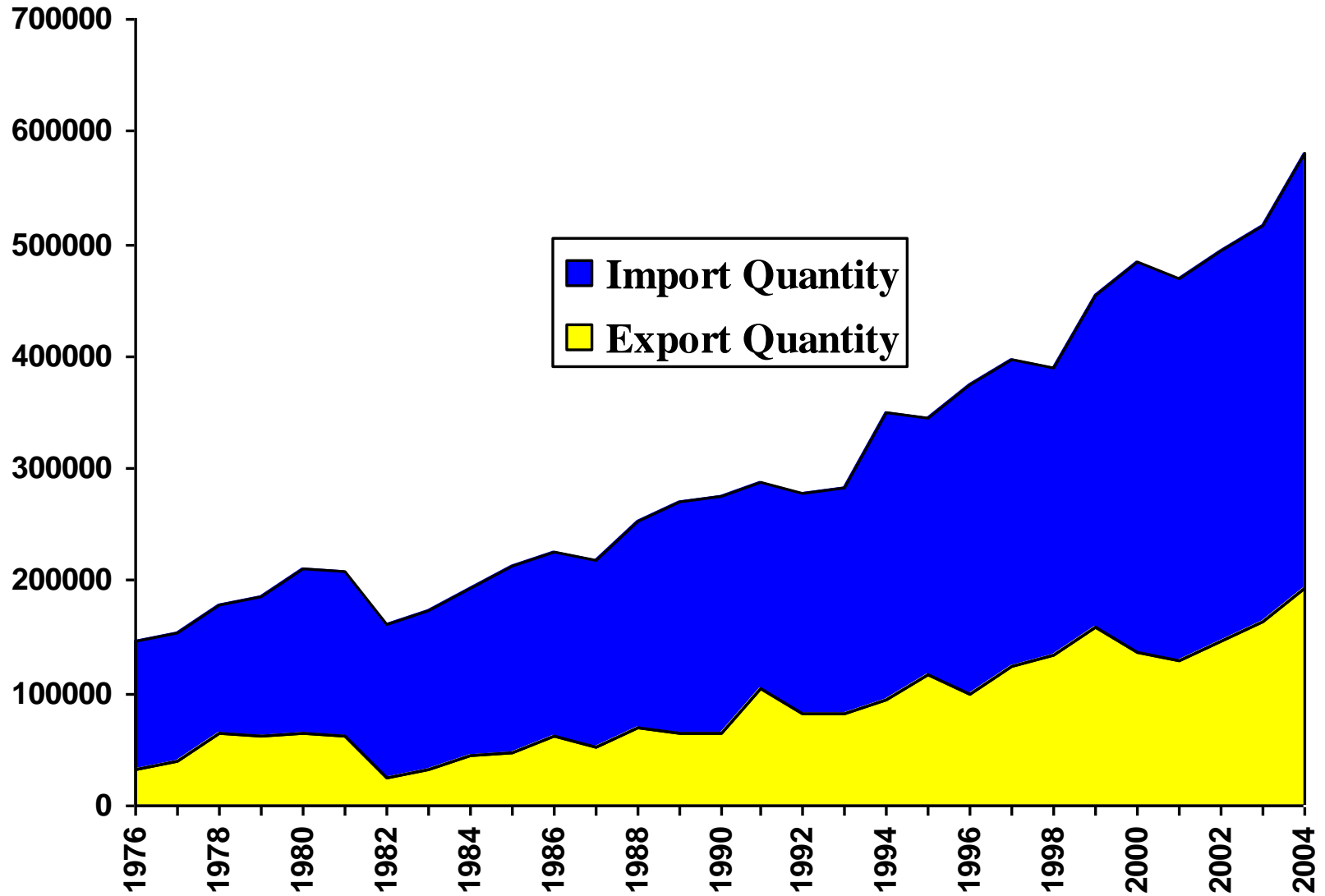
Catch by main species group in 2004



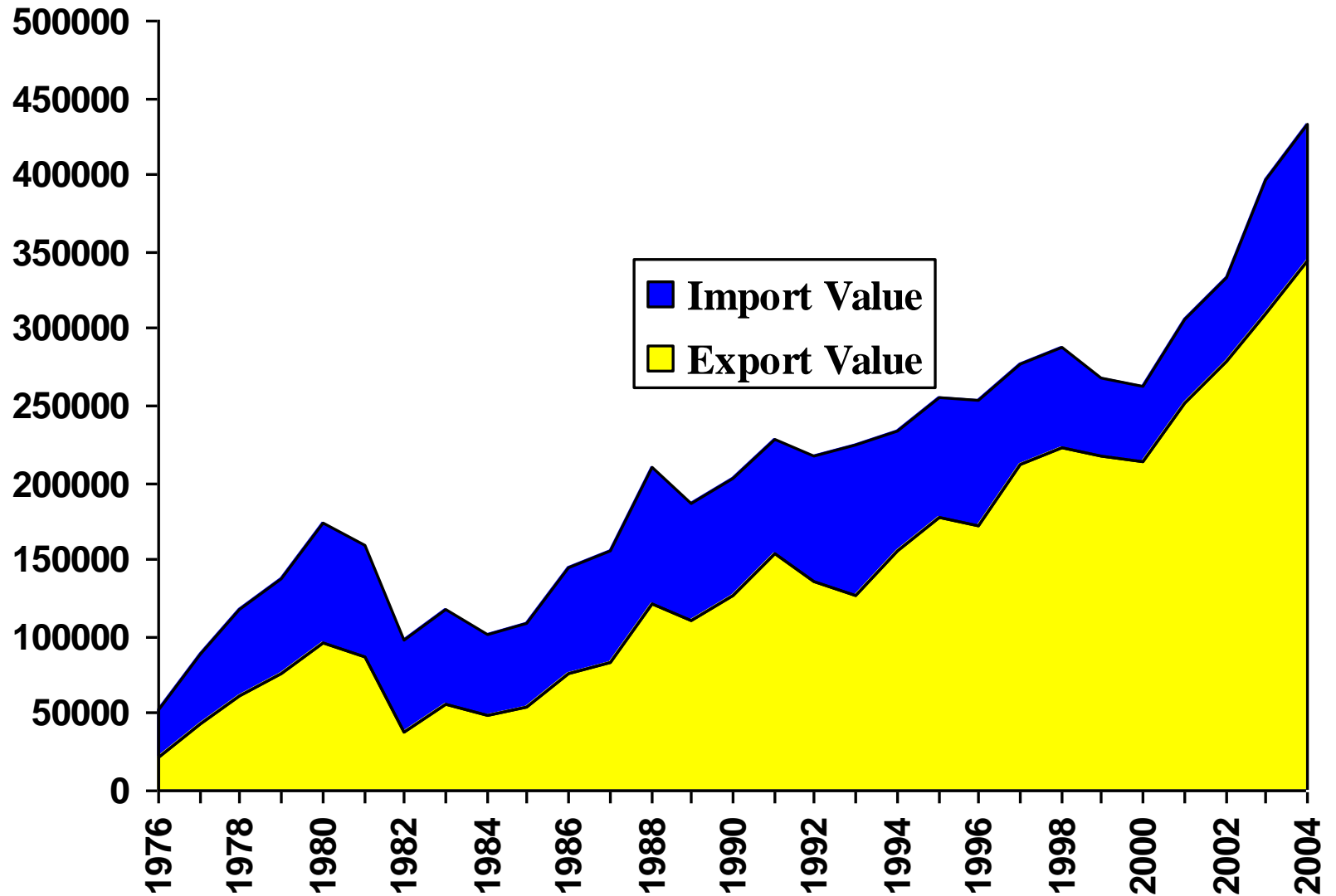
Aquaculture production (tonnes) in 2004



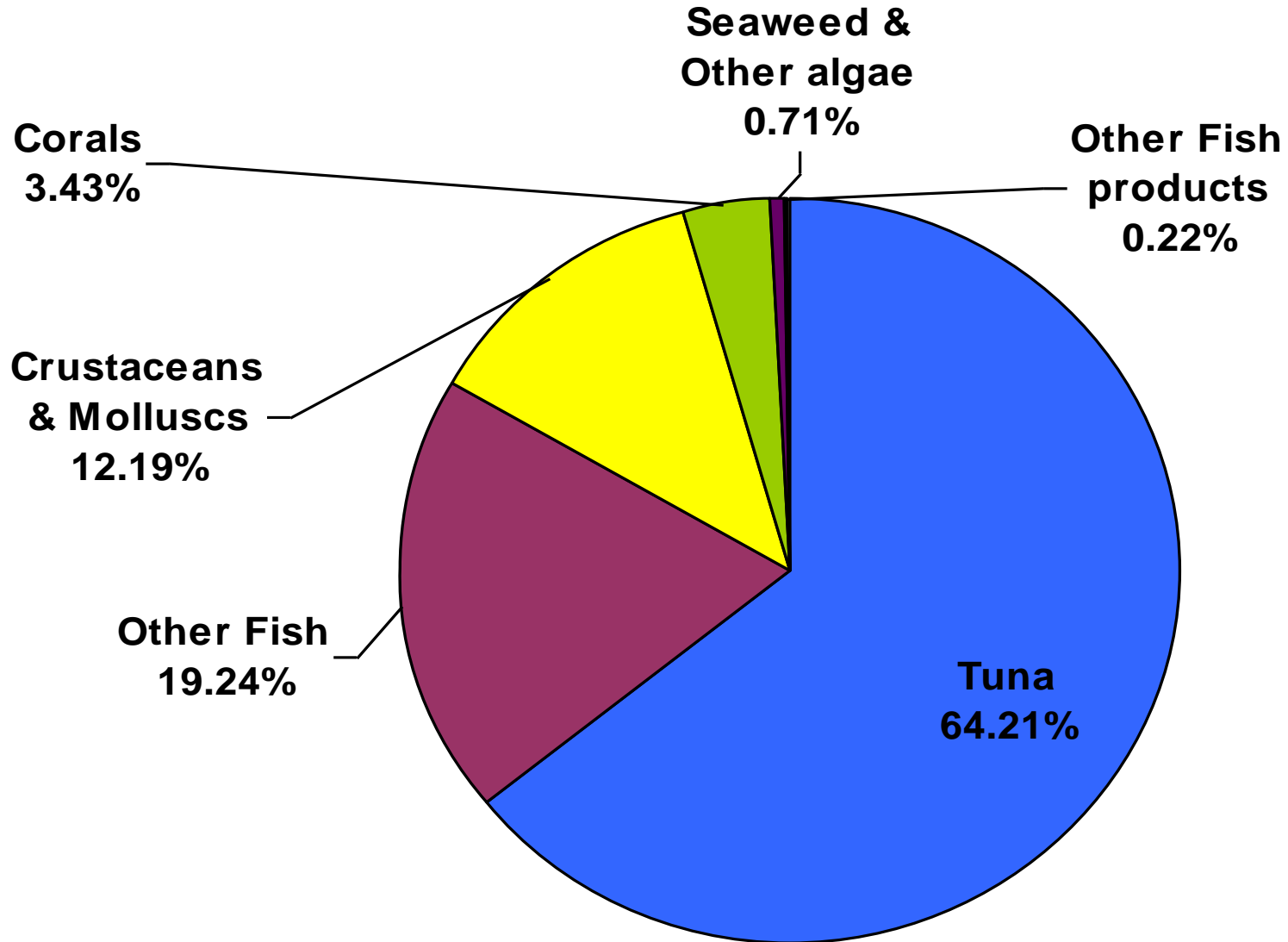
Fish Trade – Quantity (tonnes)

Export Value distribution by main species group in 2004



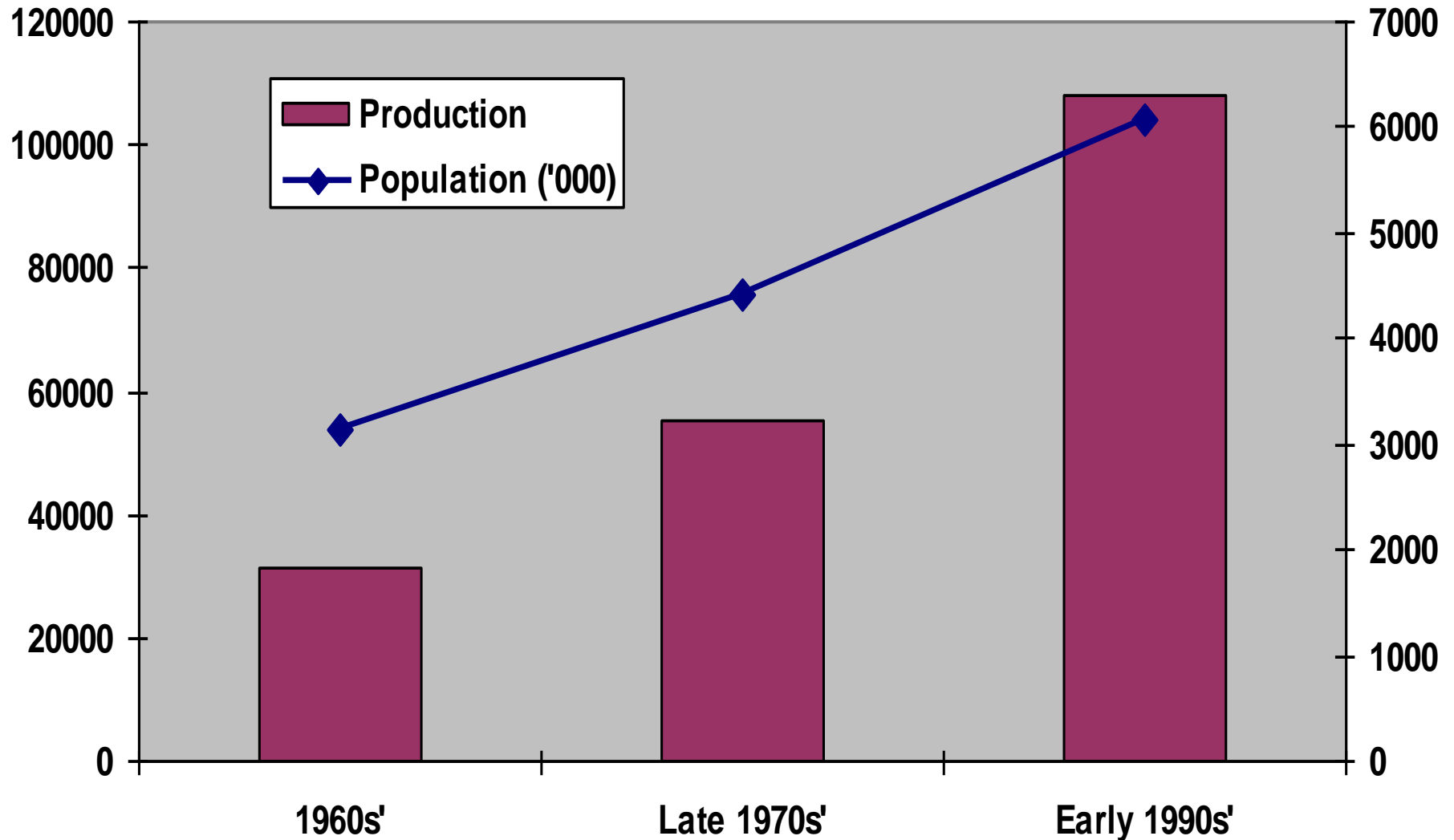

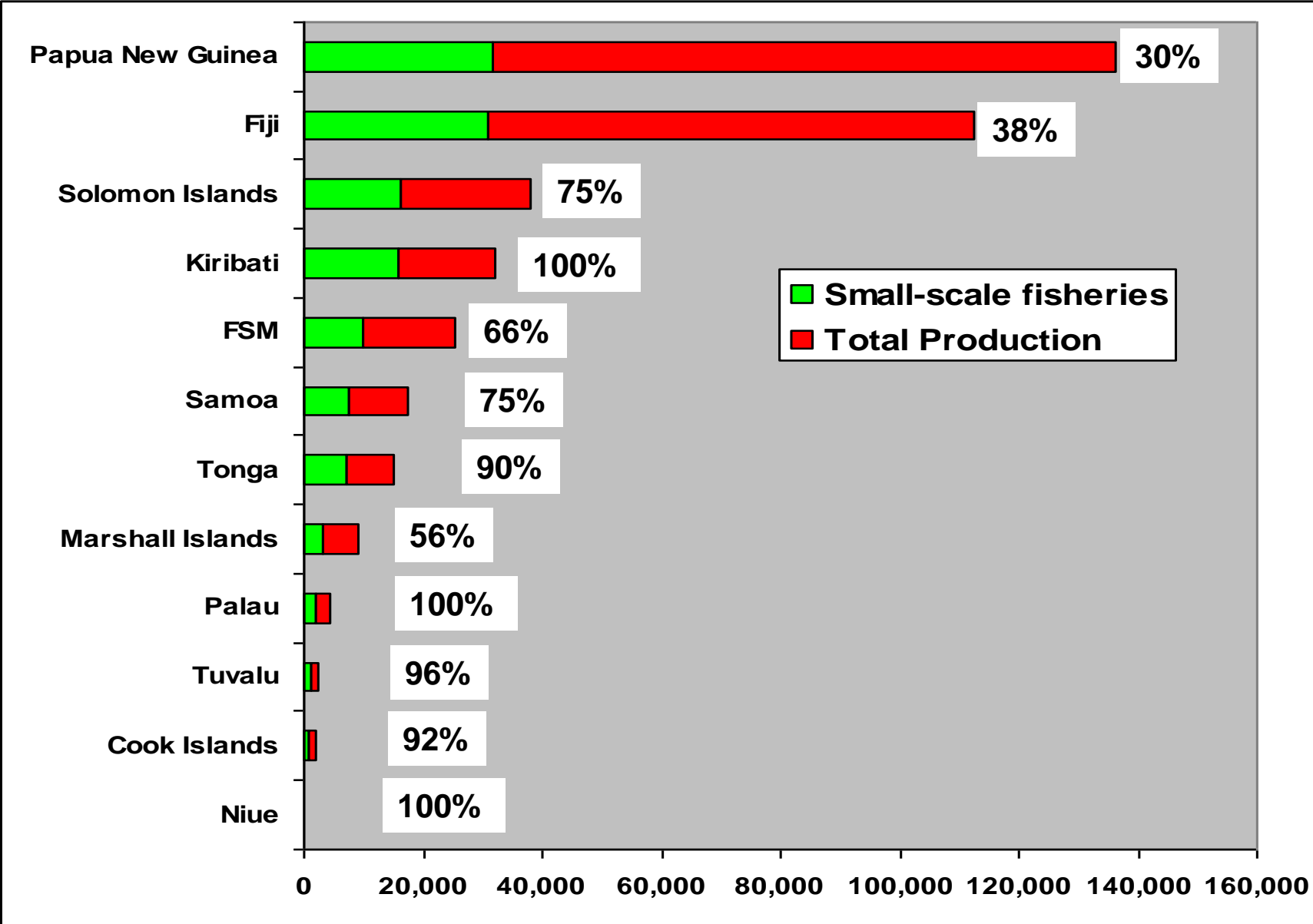

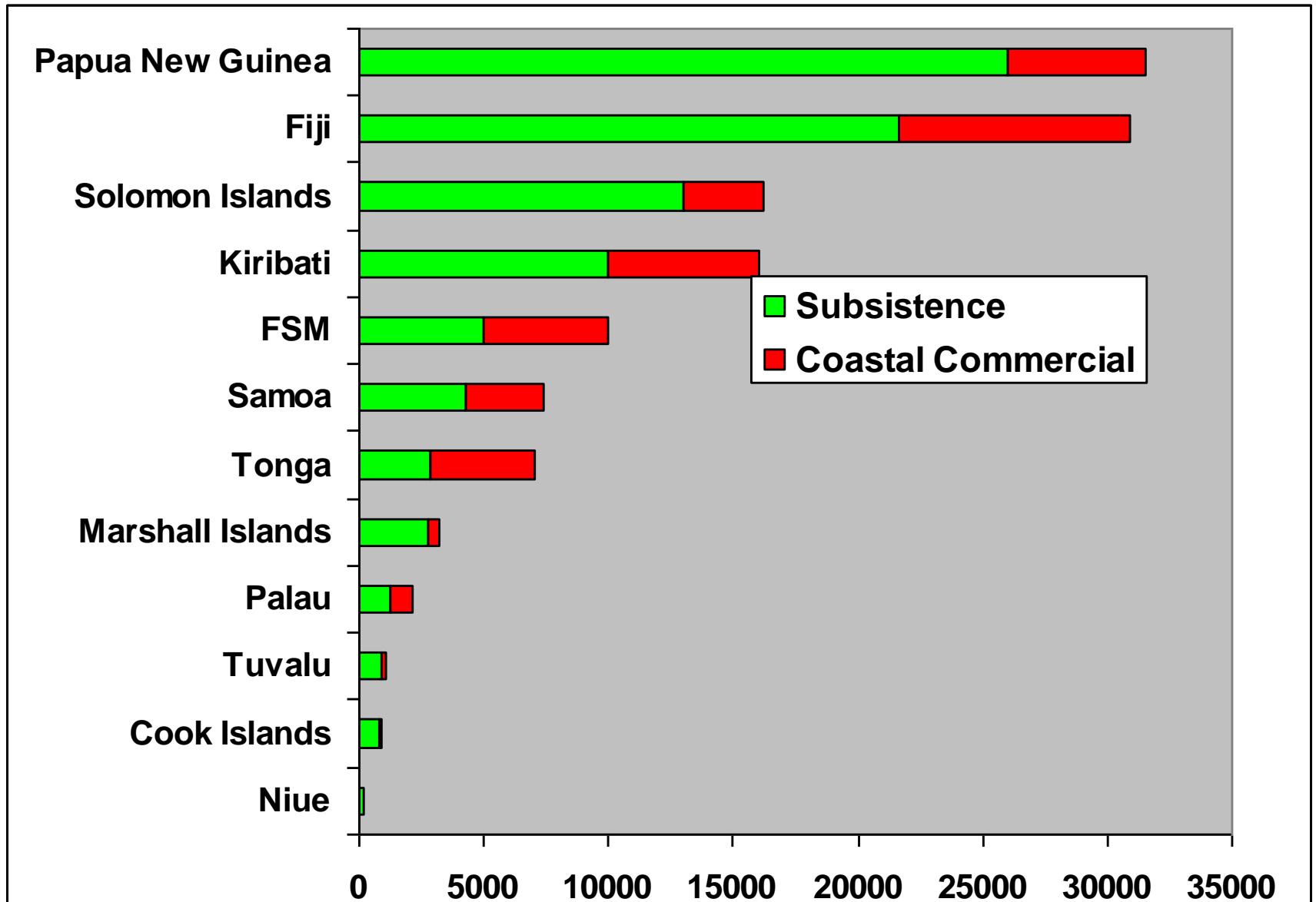
Small-scale fisheries production (tonnes) in the South Pacific Region from 1960s' to 1990s'

Breakdown of small-scale fisheries for some Pacific Islands in the late 1990s'

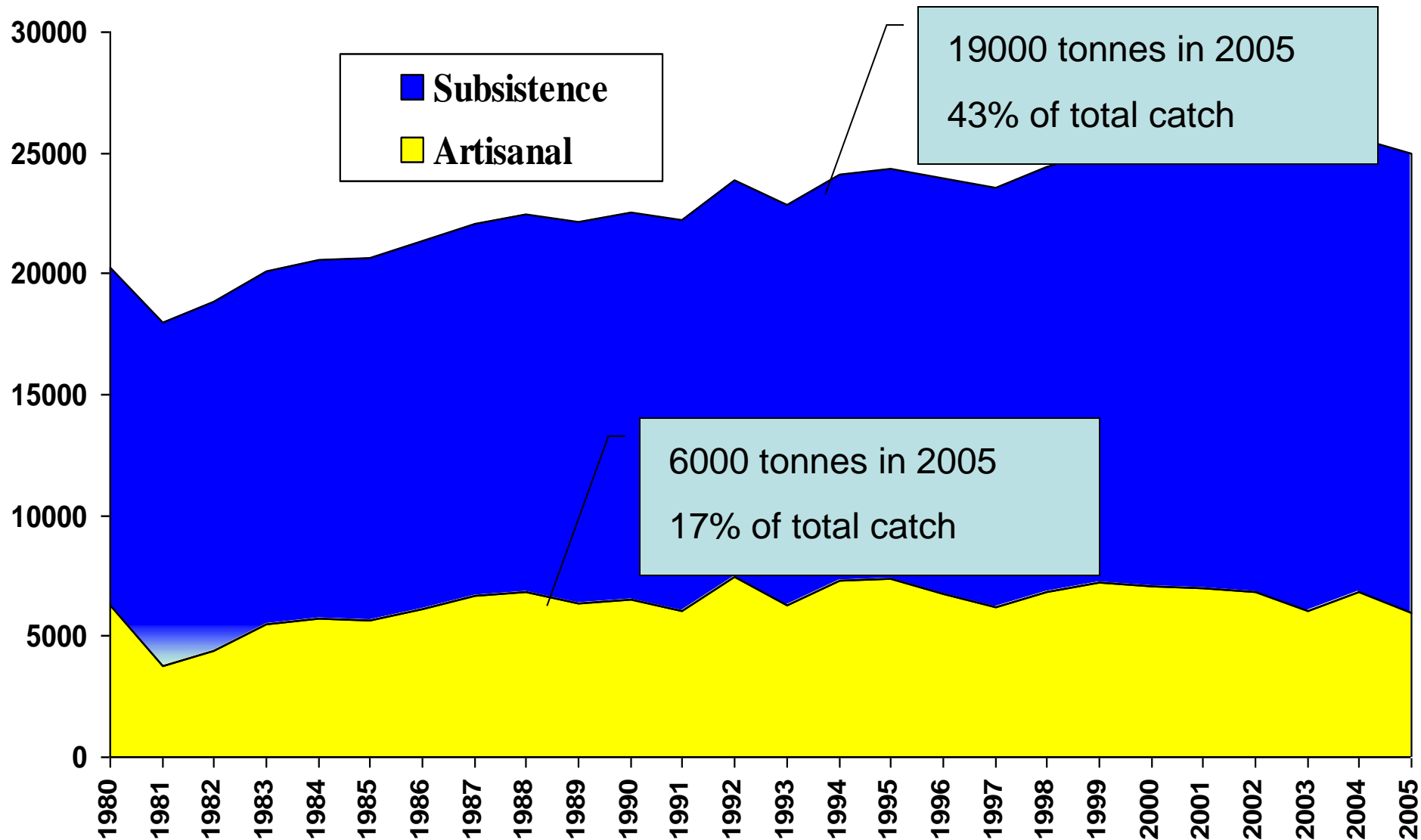

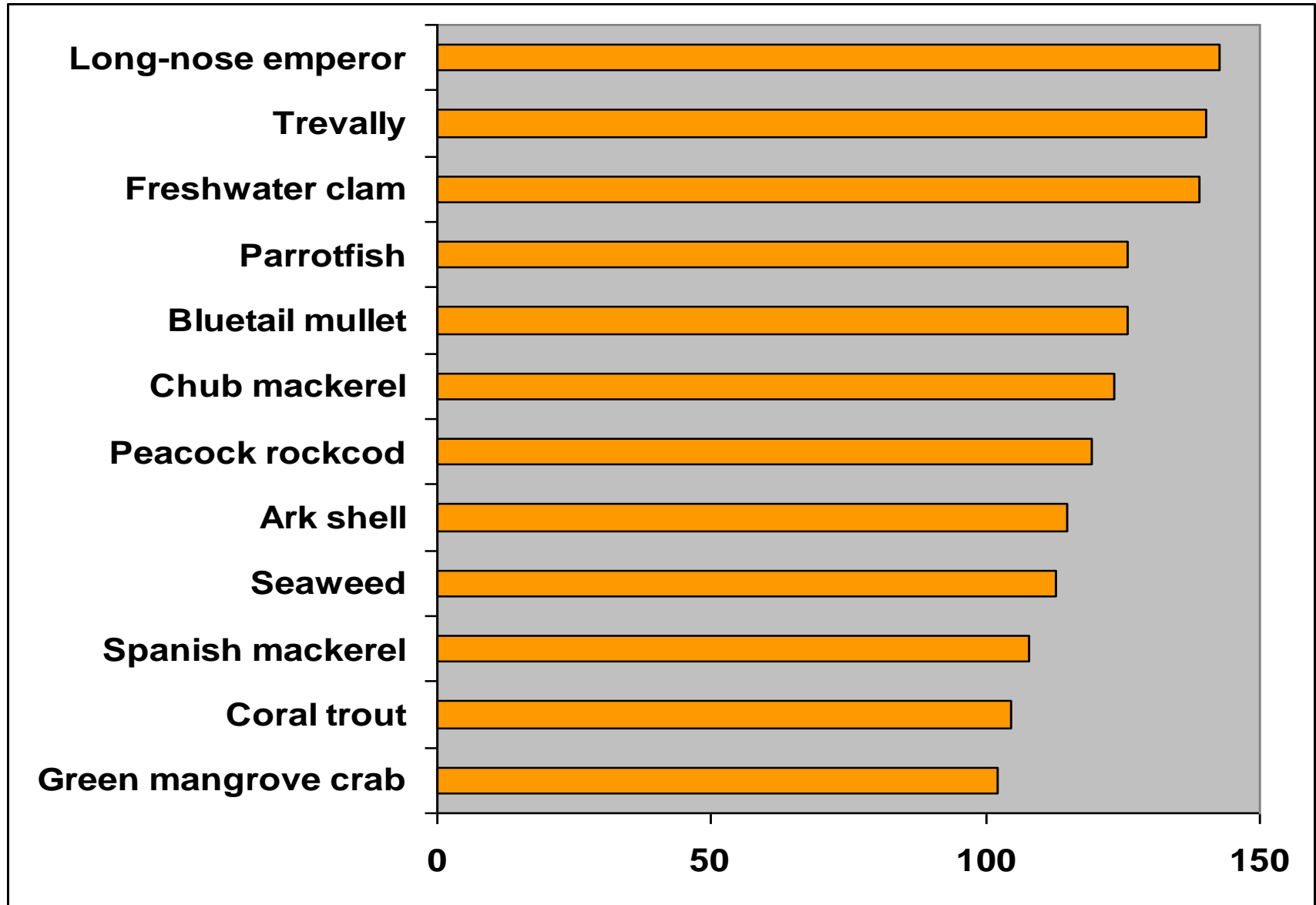

Fiji Small-scale fisheries production (tonnes)

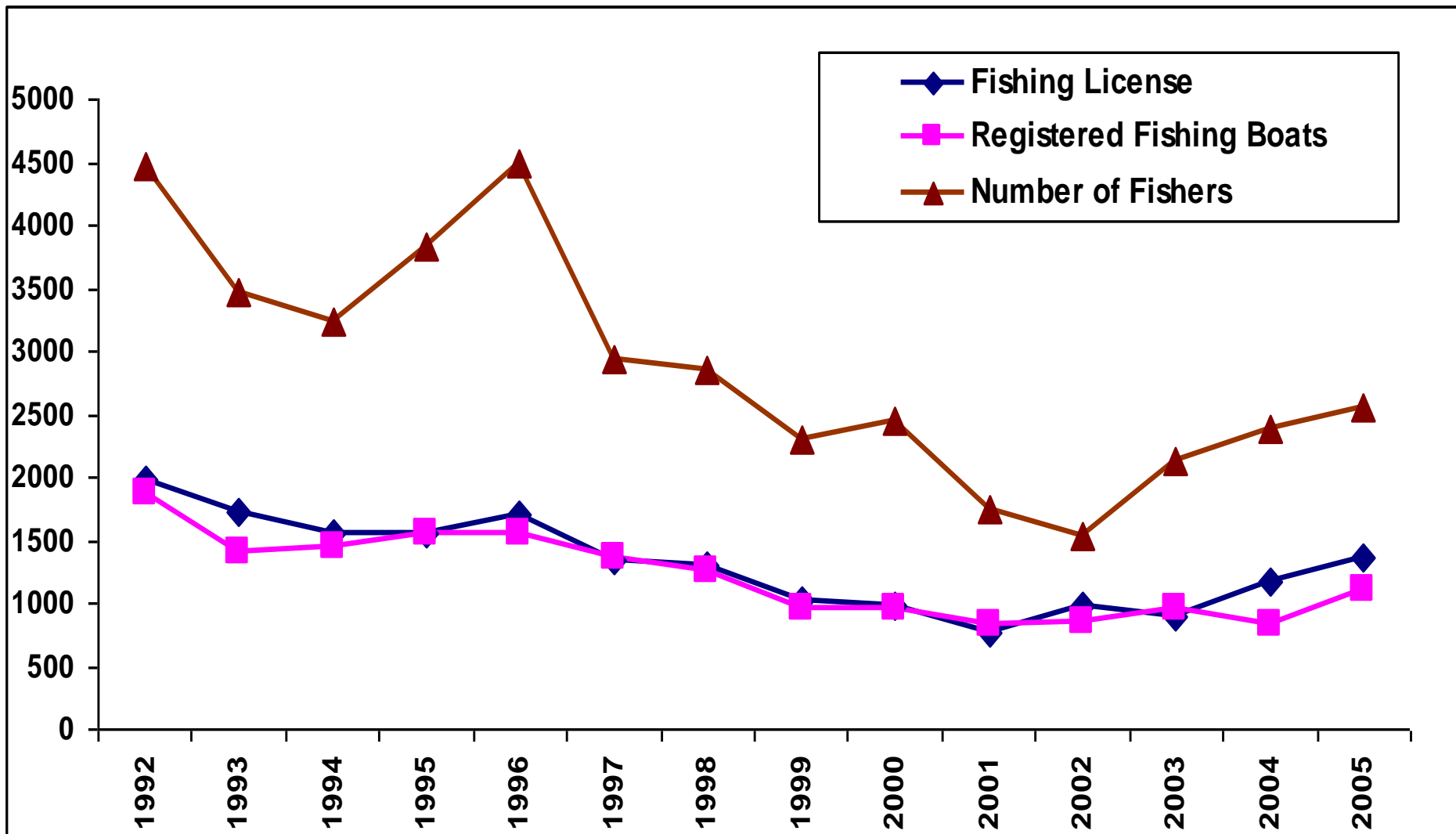

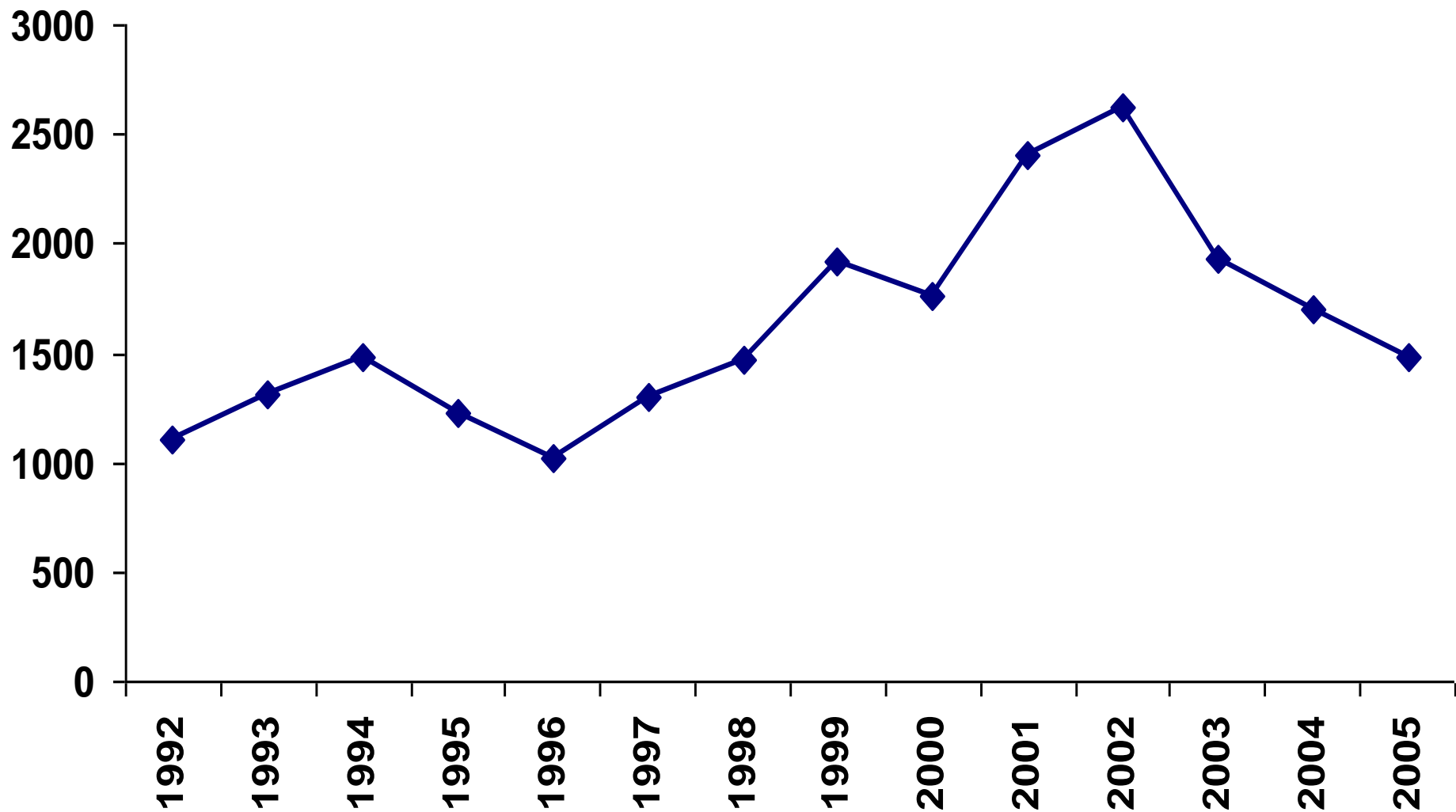
Prominent species in 2005 with production >100 tonnes
